1. SERS is making huge errors on State of IL Retirees monthly annuity checks. SRS Executive management was made aware of system faults and questionable audit checks but are trying to keep it out of public knowledge. Examples:

- David Sharp case
- case
- Newly discovered Carolyn Brown Hodge (overpayment of \$300,000+ over 4 years)
Do your legwork – worked in Quinn's office and was 'let go' for campaign activity at work
- Bill Zettler asking right questions – see him for FOIA info
- There are more mistakes.....
- Pension bill sb3309 trying to fix mistakes

2. Audit Finding revealed issues with SERS Executive Management.

- Spent \$2 million + on new project 20% complete after 4 years.
- Recent Capitol Fax article
- Two SRS internal auditors forced out by SERS Executive staff after audit documented system faults and inadequate standards. (*do your legwork* – Larry Stone, Staci Crane)

3. Continued after news report –

- Blair indicates there are "no more mistakes". There are other mistakes, not as extreme as Hodge, but overpayments. Topinka and Board are and were aware of faults of the current pension application, but chose to wait until after sb3309 AND election to deal with overpayments. In the meantime, auditors who found issues are forced out and no current internal auditor has been hired. Topinka, Blair and Blair's Executive staff are all part of the cover up and anyone that knows too much are harassed and retaliated against.
